- 1. Call to order- 6:02 by Landon Forth, second by Jyll Green.
 - a. Introductions-new participant Kim Landry.

2. Approval of Minutes

a. Approve April meeting minutes. Minutes were not finalized due to Jyll being out of town-will recreate with Landon and submit via email for approval.

3. Principal's Report

- a. Graduation is Monday 5/12 at 6:30. Doors open at 5:30 at the Alaska Airlines Center. Graduates can enter a little earlier through a side door.
- b. School board on Tuesday night passed an amendment that is unfunded so far at \$560 BSA increase. With this budget, 60.3 teachers were going to be cut and now 30.1 teachers will be cut with the additional funding. May 19 is when the actual staffing event will happen. South did not get an admin and counseling position back. History and English classes are large so they are looking to hire someone to teach both and will also offer pay bump to existing teachers to teach 6/6 periods to fill the gap.

4. Teacher Representative Report—

- a. One grant request from Sara Miller-\$100 for weekly prizes for staff for Healthy Futures 100 Miles in May. Uses process to encourage exercise in May at the end of the school when teachers are dragging. Motion to approve by Jyll Green and seconded by Dr. Almon. None opposed.
- b. There was a second grant request from Lydia Frankeburger on behalf of the science department to pay for half of a special speaker Patrick O'Neil. He will come in September to Alaska to present. Needs 20 schools to commit to coming to Alaska (6 more are needed). Dr. Almon motions to approve, Dane Senaga seconds. None opposed.
- c. Kim has a bunch of thank you notes from teachers for the PTSO efforts on Teacher Appreciation Week this week. Many thanks.
- d. Tara Devlin sent a thank you note.

e. Kim wants to recognize the wonderful student volunteers. Dane has served for 2 years and is going to Colorado State. Rebecca has also volunteered for 2 years and is going to the University of Utah for biology. Ethan will give IG responsibilities to Aubrey. Dane would like to express that Facebook is almost as cool as IG. Student volunteers would like to retire our SnapChat efforts-it isn't the right mode for advertising events. Facebook works great for the parents-Rebecca and Dane thinks they found a sophomore to take over.

5. Student Report

a. Nothing else to report—new student PTSO members as discussed.

- i. Thanks to Aubrey for volunteering. Aubrey was just nominated as a core commander for ROTC next year.
- ii. Landon and Amber attended prom and said he was so impressed with the behavior of the students. No incidents that he heard of. There were 15 staff members there to volunteermost of them were invited by the students. This is an amazing accomplishment.
- iii. On Monday, the Bo Seward award was awarded to Ariana Smith, and she chose Clare House as her recipient and they will receive \$500. She receives \$3000. They presented the award to her at the choir concert. He was very impressed by the concert.
- iv. Landon delivered staff lunch this week and everyone was so happy and so thankful. The culture at South is admirable.
- v. Need to get through elections for the four board positions tonight. We will appoint committee members later (no votes required).
- vi. Due for a bylaws update.

b. Treasurer's Report

- i. Still some things outstanding. Needs to process a few grants. Still a lot in the grant fund-\$4000-5000 available.
- ii. Spirit wear was over budget.
- iii. School store earnings were higher than expected--\$67800 vs \$53000 anticipated.
- iv. More donations than expected as well--\$1900 vs \$1000 expected.
- v. Steamdot donated coffee cards for the teachers.
- vi. Excess of \$24000 in the budget. There is usually a rush of grant requests at the end of the school year to get set for next year. Dr. Almon may have requests for some material costs. There are still some outstanding expenses to account for senior activities and the hospitality room at graduation.
- vii. Audit report completed by a parent-present for review today.

7. Committee Reports

a. Senior Events

- Successful senior events. Cristy suggests that next year that prom, fun day, and the other
 events are not all in the same week. Prom was pushed back this year due to Easter
 holiday.
